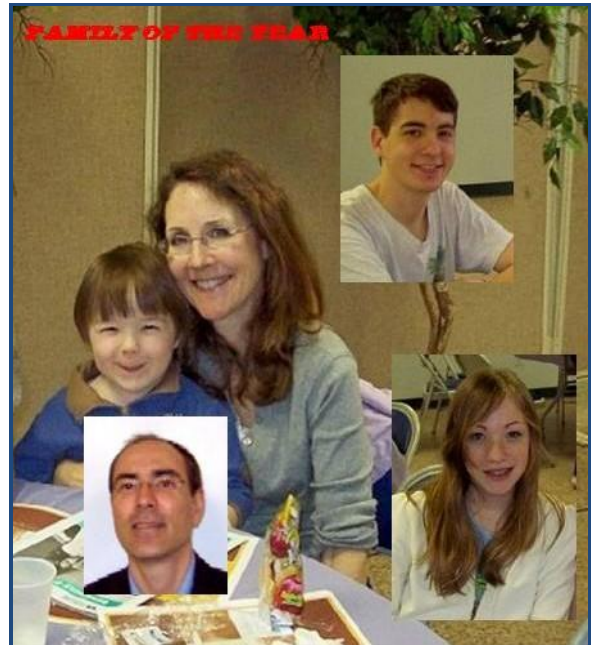

Currently our facility is being used by various community and non-profit organizations. As such, anyone who wishes to use our facility must get pre-approval at least two weeks before its intended use. Pre-approval requests may be submitted in writing, or by contacting FDD/PGK Richard Owen at (703) 941-3848 or Vincent Apostolico at (703) 941-1079. If and when anyone is using our facility and is using an authorized access card, they MUST answer the phone. We recently had someone using our facility, who set the alarm off, and the alarm company was about to call the police because the person who set the alarm off did not answer the phone when the alarm company called. That would have resulted in a \$100 fine. The alarm company was able to contact an authorized representative who went to the facility and eventually advised the alarm company not to call the police.

Due to recent changes in our alarm system with a limited number of key cards, all current access key cards must be turned in and re-registered through our system. All current cards should be turned in no later than July 15, 2009. At that time, all cards not re-registered will be denied access.
