Grand Knight's Message

I would like to start by expressing my sincere gratitude to all the members who supported and participated in the fish fry activity. Dear members of the Pope John Paul II Council 4522, I want to express my concerns about our Council. As many of you may agree, we are facing challenges in filling officer and director positions, which has impacted attendance at our meetings and participation in our programs.

This issue has persisted for several years now. I understand that some of us may not be interested in attending Council meetings every month, but I encourage everyone to aim for quarterly attendance.

Unfortunately, we are not even reaching that goal. The participation rate has been so low that we often struggle to meet quorum for voting. Let's work together to improve our attendance and engagement in the Council.

When we organize programs, it often happens that only the members who attend meetings participate in the activities. For instance, we face challenges in filling the adoration hours, resulting in the same few members covering those shifts. We scheduled a retreat, but only about six members attended. Currently, we are struggling to fill the offices in the Council. According to the bylaws of the Order, if we are

unable to fill these offices, we cannot have a functioning Council.

Every other council that has separated from the original council is establishing a strong parish council, while the original council is struggling. What can we do to increase our members in 4522; interest in the council, and are there things we should stop doing? Do we want the council associated with the most beautiful parish in the diocese to close?

We need to come together to build up and strengthen our Council. Council 4522 has a lot to offer. We have the support of our pastor and parochial vicar. We could be one of the most exciting Councils in the Commonwealth of Virginia. It is important that we not allow this Council to be closed.

Let me use this opportunity to remind us of the next fish fry on Friday, April 11, 2025. The officers and directors' meeting on Wednesday, April 2nd, and the business meeting on Wednesday, April 9th.


