The Establishment of the Kingdom of God

Excerpts from a recent parish letter by Fr. Diaz (Council Chaplain)

"During these two weeks [from recent surgery], I have had time to meditate on the evangelizing process of our parish...we still have a long way to go, which is why we must begin to work with more emphasis on the establishment of the kingdom of God among us. That means making a concrete commitment to the Gospel of the Lord. We see that reflected in this Sunday's Gospel. We read in today's Gospel that Jesus sends the Twelve, two by two, to preach. Until now, you have accompanied the Master along the roads of Galilee, but the time has come to begin the spread of the Gospel, the Good News: the news that our Father God loves us with infinite love and that He has brought us to life to make us happy for all eternity. This news is for everyone. No one should be left out of the liberating teaching of Jesus. No one is excluded from the Love of God. It is necessary to reach the last corner of the world. We must announce the joy of total and universal salvation through Jesus Christ, the Son of God who made man for us, died and resurrected, and is actively present in the Church.

The effectiveness of His evangelizing preaching will not come from human or material influences but from the power of God and the sincerity, faith, and testimony of the preacher's life. "All the impulse, energy, and dedication of evangelizers come from the source that is the love of God infused into our hearts with the gift of the Holy Spirit" (Saint John Paul II). The Good News has

yet to reach everywhere nor with the necessary intensity. <u>Conversion must be preached; many evil</u> spirits must be defeated.

Editor's note: One of the pillars of being a stalwart of the Knights of Columbus is evangelization—between us, our families, our friends, those we work with, those that we cross paths with along the road of life. Come to the monthly Men's Encounters, come to the annual Council retreat, come to any or all of the Council's activities. Evangelization will come to you—and you will be better equipped to pass it on to others.

A Note from our Lecturer - God's Perfect Timing

"I am the Lord; in its time I will do this swiftly."

Very often we find it difficult to accept God's timing, but we must never get impatient with the fact that He does not always react when we want Him too. It is wrong to try to subject the omniscient God to your timetable. We only see the circumstances and problems that weigh us down now, while God sees the bigger picture from an eternal perspective. God's timing is always perfect, even though it may not seem that way to you now. When His will becomes our primary concern, then we will start to understand God's perfect timing and will no longer be subject to fits of anxiety caused by circumstances.

"Lord, You are omnipresent. When I lose all hope, You are there. Thank You that I may know that my Life is safe in your hands. Amen"
